1482. CRYNANT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MATTERS

Members were provided with a brief update on maintenance matters of the Community Centre. All Members were provided with an information pack of the Association's income and expenditure. After further discussion and information regarding proposed timelines for next steps,

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It was proposed, seconded, and **RESOLVED** to approve the Crynant Community Association Constitution and for Council to continue to progress to becoming the sole trustee.
